Check your local clubs for dates and times. All ACBL members in good standing in our district are encouraged to qualify. ## SCHEDULE

- Club-level qualifiers may be held in June, July and August (both online and face to face)
- Unit-level qualification is not required
- District-level finals will be held at the Palm Springs Regional in a two-session event on Sunday, December 18 starting at 9:30AM
- National-level finals will be held at the Spring NABC in New Orleans, LA.
  - Mar 8-9 – Flight A
  - Mar 18-19 – Flights B & C

## DISTRICT FINALS ENTRY FEES

Card fees will be \$15 per person per session

## ELIGIBILITY

Flight A – Over 2,500 Masterpoints [ACBL Open Chart]

Flight B – Under 2,500 Masterpoints [ACBL Basic+ Chart] as of June 2022

Flight C – Non-Life Master under 500 Masterpoints [ACBL Basic Chart] as of June 2022

Please note that players with a principal residence outside District 22 are no longer grandfathered.

## FORMAT

All flights will compete at the same time. There will be two sessions. The movement will be determined by the Director In Charge.

## QUALIFIERS/SUBSIDIES

Flight A qualifies the top 3 pairs in the district finals to the National level, while Flights B and C qualify the top 4 pairs in the District finals to the National level.

Subsidies intended to offset the cost of travel to the 2023 New Orleans NABC have not yet been determined by the ACBL. If the event is held face to face, the District will supplement the ACBL travel stipends.
